Dear Colleagues, we are pleased to invite you to the 2nd LIMPE Seminar "Old and New Dopamine Agonists: a Reappraisal", which will be held at the Congress Center of Pisa (Italy) from February 26 to 28, 2009. Abstracts can only be submitted online via the online abstract submission system on www.parkinsonpisa.it.

Capitalise the title, the name and the address of the presenter. Avoid boldfacing, italics and underlining in the text. Use only standard abbreviations. Abbreviations should not be used in the title. Type font Times New Roman size 12 pt preferred.

Each abstract will include:

- Title
- Authors names (initials and family name).
- Affiliations of all abstract authors: Department, Institution/Company, City, Country.
- Abstract text is limited to a maximum of 250 words. Figures and tables are not allowed.
- E-mail address of presenting author.

Abstracts sent by post or email will not be accepted. No exceptions will be made.
